Parish Council have been discussing ways in which our parish can support Chikelue in the ministry he leads among the indigenous community in Whitmore Square through *Good Intention Ministry*. This Ministry actively ministers in the community, especially the Aboriginal community, leading individuals to Christ through pastoral care, preaching, and acts of practical compassion. Ministry activities include spiritual development through bible studies and prayer sessions, evangelical outreach, and weekly food distributions to vulnerable families and individuals.

Soon there will be a box placed at the back of St Philip's where donations of food items can be placed for anyone who is able to donate items – similar to those that are put in the Anglicare basket. Please pray for Chikelue, and those who assist him in this Ministry.
